



## **Gidi Grinstein**

Gidi Grinstein (36) is the Founder and President of "*The Reut Institute – From Vision to Policy*", a non-partisan, non-profit policy team based in Tel Aviv. The Reut Institute is uniquely designed to strengthen the vision of Israel as a Jewish, democratic and prosperous state by enhancing the capacity of the Government of Israel to incorporate long-term thinking into its on-going decision making.

Gidi's previous positions include Secretary and Coordinator of the Israeli negotiation team on the Permanent Status Agreement between Israel and the PLO in the Office and later in the Bureau of Prime Minister Ehud Barak (1999-01).

Gidi is the founder of *Yesodot Group* for reforming Israeli Governance; a member of *Kol-Dor Group* for global Jewish Peoplehood; a former member of "*Israel 2025 – Scenarios for Future Developments*"; and a founding member of a group that worked to realize the vision of the "*Birthright Israel*" program.

Gidi is a graduate of the Tel-Aviv University schools of Economics (1991) and Law (1999) and of Harvard University Kennedy School of Government as a Wexner-Israel Fellow (2002). He is a Captain (Res.) in the Israeli Navy.
